### H1N1 Flu Shot and Nasal Spray Mist available

To get this vaccine, you must meet one of the following:

- Pregnant Women
- Household contacts and caregivers for children under 6 months old
- Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel
- Children and young adults from 6 months-24 years old
- Persons 25-64 years old who have health conditions associated with higher risk of medical complications or death from influenza

- Protect Your Family
- Protect Your Community
- Get Your H1N1 vaccine

- FREE vaccination
- Parent or legal guardian MUST be present with children under 18
- From our website [www.madisonchd.org](http://www.madisonchd.org), you can download, print, complete, and bring with you the “H1N1 Vaccine Record and HIPAA Form”
- If your child recently had FluMist, MMR, or Varicella vaccine, they must wait 28 days after that vaccine before getting the H1N1 Nasal Mist.
